TennCare is the state of Tennessee's Medicaid program. It provides healthcare to low-income pregnant women, parents or caretakers of a minor child, children, and individuals who are elderly or have a disability. To get TennCare, you must meet the income and resource limits.

What is CHOICES?

The Right Care in the Right Place at the Right Time!

Tennessee's CHOICES program provides services and supports for people in a home or community setting or in a nursing home that are:

- Older adults (age 65 and older)
- Adults with physical disabilities (age 21 and older).

CHOICES focuses on Home and Community Based Services (HCBS). The program helps you with daily activities, allowing you to live independently and be active in your local community. Or, CHOICES can give care in a nursing home if needed.



Do I qualify for CHOICES?

To qualify for CHOICES, you must meet medical and financial requirements.

Medical Requirements:

You'll need to show that you need help with daily living activities like moving around, eating, toileting, or communicating.

Financial Requirements:

- 1. You receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments; OR
- 2. You qualify for Medicaid Long-Term Services and Supports. Current requirements can be found on the TennCare CHOICES webpage.

How do I apply for CHOICES?

CHOICES Groups:

In CHOICES, members are grouped into three categories (1, 2, and 3) based on their specific needs. To join CHOICES and to get home care, your TennCare health plan (MCO) must be able to safely meet your needs.

CHOICES Group 1 is for people of all ages who get nursing home care.

CHOICES Group 2 is for adults (age 21 and older) with a physical disability and seniors (age 65 and older) who need to get nursing home care but choose to get home care instead.

CHOICES Group 3 is for adults (age 21 and older) with a disability and seniors (age 65 and older) who do not need nursing home care now but still need care to keep from needing nursing home care soon.

What is Consumer Direction?

Consumer Direction offers more control over who gives you your home care and how your care is given. You hire the people who give some of your home care. They work for you.
